# **Court News** By Chief Judge Paul P. Gilfillan



- 1. For the latest in courtroom developments in response to the Covid-19 emergency, please see www.10thcircuitcourtil.org You will find various courtroom procedures and general announcements. All are subject to change, extension, etc. Of note:
- 2. No jury trials will be held through May at this point. When trials do resume it will be on a limited basis (e.g. only one or two trials per week). This means priority trials, TBD by the chief judge, will occur first and some trials will need to be continued further. This will keep number of jurors down and allow for more spacing.
- 3. The courts are in a restricted access mode (only upon court order) for May. This new normal has forced us to adapt to remote hearings, both essential and routine, contested and evidentiary. Each courtroom operates with its own procedures, published or not, and some still on a reduced staff basis. Judges have been encouraged to

conduct matters remotely. Simply reach out to your respective courtroom clerk/judge.

- 4. If any member of the public/attorney is allowed in the courthouse, they will be expected to wear their own face covering. The County will not be supplying these as a rule, since they are rightfully reserved for County medical staff and 1st responders.
- 5. Stay safe out there. Hope to (virtually) see you soon.
